Chapter 10

- The word **BISHOP means "overseer**." The Bishop leads our Diocese.
- The POPE leads the whole Church on Earth.
- Jesus chose the **APOSTLES** to lead the Church.
- PETER was the leader of the Apostles and the FIRST head of the Church.
 The Pope and Bishops today are the direct successors of the Apostles chosen by Jesus.
- A **PASTOR** leads a Parish. Our Pastor here at Sacred Heart is Father Fred.

Chapter 11

- On PENTECOST we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit 50 days after Easter.
- The HOLY SPIRIT guides the Pope and Bishops making us ONE Church.
- SAINTS are heroes of the Church who are with God in Heaven.
- The MAIN PARTS OF THE MASS are the **SAME all** around the world.
- FAITH IN JESUS unites all Catholics all over the world.
- There are FOUR MARKS of the Church: ONE, HOLY, CATHOLIC and APOSTOLIC.

- A **MISSION** is a job or duty that someone takes responsibility for.
- The **CHURCH'S MISSION** is to announce the good news of Jesus and the kingdom of God. We can all share in that MISSION.
- MISSIONARIES are people who travel to share Jesus' good news.
- **PAUL** helped the early Christians know that the Church was for everyone by traveling all over and writing them letters, planting the seeds of faith.
- The word "CATHOLIC" means universal or everywhere, which is why our Church is called the Catholic Church.

Chapter 13

- BEATITUDES are teachings of Jesus that show us the way to true happiness.
- The **NEW COMMANDMENT** that Jesus gave us sums up the 10 Commandments and the Beatitudes.
- Jesus wants us to love our ENEMIES.
- The SIGN OF PEACE is a way to show that we are one community of believers.
- The story of JOSEPH and his brothers is a story about LOVE AND FORGIVENESS.

Chapter 14

- A **VIRTUE** is a good quality or habit of goodness that you can develop.
- **FAITH** is the VIRTUE that helps you believe in God.
- You can PRAY anytime and not just at meals or at bedtime. Any time we talk to God, we are praying.
- A **VOCATION** is God's plan for our lives, and the purpose for which He made us.

Chapter 15

- Your **CONSCIENCE** helps you make good choices.
- **SIN** is a DELIBERATE CHOICE to disobey GOD. SIN is **something we do on purpose** even though we know it is wrong.
- God's GRACE is God's free and loving gift to humans of his own life and friendship.
- We get God's FORGIVENESS, HEALING, and GRACE in the Sacrament of PENANCE and RECONCILIATION.

- SACRED **CHRISM** is the perfumed oil uses in some Sacraments.
- **SACRAMENTS** are signs that come from Jesus and give us **GRACE**.
- **HOLY EUCHARIST** or COMMUNION is when we receive the Body and Blood of Christ, usually at Mass.
- BAPTISM takes away ORIGINAL SIN from us. Original Sin is the sin that Adam and Eve did when they disobeyed God

Chapter 17

- During RECONCILIATION you confess your sins to the priest and are FORGIVEN. Reconciliation is also called Confession or Penance.
- Illnesses such as colds or flu are called PHYSICAL SICKNESS. Anointing of the Sick is the sacrament received by people who are very sick.
- Living with SIN and not going to Reconciliation can be called SPIRITUAL SICKNESS.
- Only a PRIEST can perform a Sacrament of HEALING.
- SIN is choosing to turn away from God.
- The Sacraments of **HEALING** help people physically and spiritually. The sacraments of Healing are Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick.

Chapter 18

- MATRIMONY (Marriage) is the sacrament when and man and woman become husband and wife. Matrimony is the sacrament that joins a man and woman in love and faithfulness.
- HOLY ORDERS is the Sacrament when a Bishop ordains a BAPTIZED MAN, who then becomes a PRIEST or a DEACON.
- Sacred Promises we take before God are called VOWS. People take VOWS
 in the Sacraments of Matrimony and Holy Orders.
- BAPTISM, EUCHARIST & CONFIRMATION together are the Sacraments of INITIATION which means BEGINNING.

- God made a COVENANT with ABRAHAM.
- A COVENANT is a sacred AGREEMENT or PROMISE between God and humans.
- Jesus and the first followers of Jesus were JEWISH. Later followers of CHRIST became known as CHRISTIANS.
- Jesus **FULFILLED the COVENANT** between God and His People.
- To be FAITHFUL is to be constant and loyal to your promises and commitments to God and others, just as God is faithful to you. To be FAITHFUL means keeping your promises and commitments to God.

Chapter 20

- **PEACE** is a state of calm when things are in their proper order and people settle their problems with kindness and justice.
- **JUSTICE** is giving God what is due to Him, and giving each person what he or she is due because that person is a child of God.
- Our MISSION is to SHARE THE GOOD NEWS of Jesus, make the world holy, and to serve God and one another.
- The **CHURCH** is a sign of **God's** kingdom and helps people share in the love of the Holy Trinity.
- We share in the MISSION of the Church when we work for God's kingdom by helping those who are poor or in need, standing up for people's basic rights for food, shelter, dignity and freedom, teaching people about God, and following the example of Jesus.

- **HEAVEN** is the full joy of living with God forever. God made us to know Him, love Him and serve Him and to be happy with Him in Heaven after we live our lives here in this world.
- **HELL** is our own choice to be separated from God forever, to turn away from God forever, and to choose to do serious sins and not to ever seek out or get forgiveness.
- **PURGATORY** is a state of final cleansing after death before we enter into Heaven. EVERYONE in PURGATORY will get into Heaven.
- The **LAST JUDGEMENT** is God's final triumph over and defeat of evil that will happen at the end of time when Christ returns and judges all the living and the dead.
